FLANC in partnership with the Assunah Society of Columbus is proposing to use the SWSF funds to create a family and community program that is based on the strategies of the Wraparound and Collective Impact models. FLANC is going to concentrate efforts on supplying both before school care and after school tutoring for our students. FLANC will provide multiple different services to parents and students about internet safety, bullying, mental health and other available social services. Students' educational performance will be tracked and evaluated using the NWEA MAP growth assessment. This will allow the administrative team to determine if there is a direct correlation between academic performance and participation in the Student Wellness and Success program. The overarching goal is to provide families with the tools they need to care for and support FLANC students and the greater community.
